The finished mini quilt size is approximately 24" x 27". These are the fabric requirements for the mini appliquéd version of the quilt. If you do the version with just piecing or embroidery, you will have a little fabric leftover. Please contact me at bhotinger@gmail.com if you have questions about this version. If you find any errors in the cutting or piecing conversions, these are my errors, *not Jacquelynne's*.

Fabric Requirements:

- White- 1/2 yard
- Black- fat quarter
- Green #1- 1/3 yard
- Green #2- 1/4 yard or fat quarter
- Green #3- 1/4 yard or fat quarter
- Blue- 1/3 yard
- Yellow #1- fat quarter
- Yellow #2- fat quarter (this should be a non-directional fabric)
- Yellow #3- fat eighth (9" x 21")
- Pink #1- fat eighth (9" x 21")
- Pink #2- fat eighth (9" x 21")
- Floral- fat quarter
- Backing- 1 yard 42/44" wide
- Batting- 30" x 33"

Cutting Instructions for Blocks #1-4, sashing, borders, and binding: WOF- width of fabric (fabric cut selvedge to selvedge)

White

- 1 WOF strip, 5" wide
 - (2) 5" x 9" rectangles (one for each appliquéd or embroidered background, blocks 1 & 2)
 - NOTE: if you are not doing applique or embroidery, and are using novelty/floral fabrics in the center of blocks 1 and 2, omit the (2) White rectangles.)
- 3 WOF strips, 1 1/2" wide

- (2) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" (borders)
- (2) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" (borders)
- (2) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" (borders)
- (2) 1 1/2" x 19 1/2" (borders)
- 1 WOF strip, 3 1/4" wide
 - (2) 1 3/8" x 1 3/4" (block 4)
 - (2) 1 7/8" x 3 3/4" (block 4)
 - (2) 1 3/8" x 1 1/2" (block 4)
 - (2) 2 3/8" x 2 3/4" (block 4)

Black – (fat quarter, WOF strip = 21")

- 1 WOF strip, 5"
 - 5" x 9" rectangle (block 3)
 - (2) 2 1/2" x 3 1/4" (block 2)
 - (6) 1 1/2" squares (block 1)
- 1 WOF strip, 2 3/4" wide
 - (1) 2 3/4" square (block 4)
 - (1) 1 1/2" x 2 3/4" (block 4)
 - (2) 2 5/8" x 3 1/4" (block 4)

Green #1

- 2 WOF strips, 1" wide
 - **from each strip, cut**
 - (1) 1" x 14 1/2" (borders)
 - (1) 1" x 21 1/2" (borders)
- (3) 2" or 2 1/4" width of fabric strips (binding), I like to use a smaller binding width on small quilts

Green #2

- 1 WOF strips, 1" wide
 - (2) 1" x 5 1/2" strips (block 3)
 - (2) 1" x 8 1/2" strips (block 3)
- (1) 4 1/2" square (borders)

Green #3

- 1 WOF strips, 1" wide
 - (2) 1" x 5 1/2" strips (block 4)
 - (2) 1" x 8 1/2" strips (block 4)
- (1) 4 1/2" square (borders)

Blue

- (2) WOF strips, 2 1/2" wide
 - **from one strip, cut**
 - (1) 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" (borders)
 - (1) 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" (borders)
 - (1) 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" (borders)
- 1 WOF strip, 3 1/2" wide
 - (1) 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" strip (borders)

Yellow #1 (fat quarter, WOF strip = 21")

- 1 WOF strip, 4 1/2" wide
 - (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" (block 4)
 - (4) 1 1/8" squares (block 4)
 - (2) 1 3/8" x 2" (block 4)
 - (2) 1 3/8" x 2 3/4" (block 4)
 - (2) 7/8" squares (block 4)
 - (1) 4 1/2" square (borders)
- 1 WOF strip, 2 5/8" wide
 - (2) 2 5/8" x 3 1/4" (block 4)
 - (2) 2 3/8" x 2 3/4" (block 4)

Yellow #2 (fat quarter, WOF strip = 21")

- 1 WOF strip, 4 1/2" wide
 - (1) 4 1/2" square (borders)
 - from piece leftover from the 4 1/2" x WOF strip above:
 - 3 WOF strip, 1 1/2" wide
 - (12) 1 1/2" squares (6 for block 1 and 6 for block 2)
 - (1) 1 1/2" x 1 3/4" (block 4)
 - (1) 1 1/2" x 2 3/4" (block 4)

Mini Revisions written by Brenda Hotinger

- 1 WOF strip, 2 1/8" wide
 - (6) 2 1/8" squares (block 1)
- 1 WOF strip, 3 1/4" wide
 - (6) 2 1/2" x 3 1/4" (block 2)
- 1 WOF strip, 1 7/8" wide
 - (2) 1 7/8" x 3 3/4" (block 4)

Yellow #3

- (1) 4 1/2" square (borders)
- (5) 1 1/2" squares (borders), cornerstone pieces on white border instead of quarter square triangle units

Pink #1

- (2) 4 1/2" squares (borders)
- (4) 2 1/2" x 3 1/4" rectangles (block 2)

Pink #2

- (1) 4 1/2" square (borders)
- (6) 2 1/8" squares (block 1)

Floral

- 2 WOF strips, 3 1/2" wide
 - (10) 3 1/2" squares (borders)

OPTIONAL- Novelty/Floral

For blocks 1 and 2, if not doing applique or embroidery, cut a 3 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangle for each block, in place of the White background fabric.
